Role Specifics

Key working relationships: Fundraising Team, Marketing Team, National Office Staff, Donors and Supporters

Job Purpose: This customer service role will see you nurturing long term relationships with new and existing supporters to grow loyalty and reduce attrition rates. By securing reliable revenue streams, this role provides the foundation and financial wherewithal for Canteen to continue to support young people living with cancer.

Duties and Responsibilities: Note Writing volunteers work in collaboration with the fundraising team members to provide handwritten notes and cards.

The Note Writing Team will support various departments and projects across Canteen. The specific tasks and content will vary from project to project, but the essential tasks will be:

- Attend the Newtown office to collect note writing packs
- · Neatly produce handwritten notes and cards following pre-prepared scripts
- Ensuring accuracy of preparation, marrying pre-prepared address labels to correct supporter
- Returning completed packs to the Newtown office promptly
- · Ensuring confidentiality and professionalism at all times



Role Specifics cont.

Requirements of the Role

- Very neat handwriting is essential
- · Ability to attend the office at Newtown during business hours (Monday Friday)

Personal Qualities

- Warm and approachable
- Ability to listen actively
- Friendly and professional
- · High level of integrity, honesty and commitment
- · Strong attention to detail and good initiative

We anticipate that this role will be completed remotely, with volunteers 'working from home' while we navigate the current omicron uncertainty. Canteen takes a very cautious approach given the people we support are often immune suppressed.

However, in time, we hope to make this a more social volunteering opportunity, so may eventually establish a regular office roster.

Hour of Work

Working from home allows for flexible engagement. We aim to prepare packs that take around 2-3 hours to complete and volunteers will be able to collect as many packs as they feel they can complete in the time we have.

Pre-Engagement Checks

As Canteen's work involves staff being in direct contact with children and young people, all staff, whether paid or unpaid are required to complete police and working with children checks, relevant to the state in which they will be engaged.

Canteen will conduct at least two reference checks on successful applicants and may also require proof of any professional qualifications stated on an application.

General Information

All staff, whether paid or unpaid are required to adhere to Canteen's Code of Conduct and Human Resources Policies during the course of their engagement.
