

Canteen – The Australian Organisation for Young People Living with Cancer (**Canteen**) – membership policy

1. Background

Canteen provides support to young people 12-25 years dealing with either their own cancer diagnosis or that of a close family member.

Canteen is a member-led organisation with the members drawn from among the young people that Canteen supports.

Section 5.2(b) of the Canteen Constitution states that the definition of a member of Canteen shall be defined within the membership policy. This policy sets out the eligibility criteria for membership as well as the rights and obligations, and application procedures.

2. Eligibility for membership

- (a) An individual is eligible for membership if they are:
 - (1) 16-25 years of age; and
 - (2) Current or previous users of one or more of the following professionally led services (face to face or online) including:
 - Canteen's Services (including programs or recreational events) and/or
 - Youth Cancer Services; and/or
 - Cancer Hub; and/or
 - Canteen Youth Leadership roles; and/or
 - Any other service operated by Canteen as determined by the board.

2. Rights and obligations

- (b) Members have the right to:
 - · receive notices; and
 - · attend, participate and vote at general meetings; and
 - nominate candidates for election to the board; and
 - apply for Canteen youth leadership roles, including member directorship, local leadership, Youth Advisory Team, peer mentor, young ambassador.
- (c) Members agree to support Canteen's purposes and comply with the constitution.

3. Application process

3.1. Application for membership

- (a) A person may apply to become a member by completing and submitting an application for membership to Canteen by completing an online form on the Canteen website which also states that the applicant: submitting an application for membership
 - (1) wishes to become a member of Canteen;
 - (2) supports the purposes of Canteen; and
 - (3) agrees to be bound by Canteen's constitution and membership policy.
- (b) The applicant must also provide details of how they are eligible for membership in accordance with the criteria outlined above.

3.2. Consideration of application

- (a) As soon as practicable after an application for membership is received, the board, or it's delegate must decide by resolution whether to accept or reject the application.
- (b) The secretary must notify the applicant of the board's decision as soon as practicable after the decision is made and update the member register.
- (c) No reason need be given for the rejection of an application.
